West Virginia PTA is currently seeking interested PTA members to join its team! The 2017- 2019 Leadership Team will be comprised of elected officers and at-large member, appointed board members, and appointed non-board members that will serve on various committees.

Being a member of the West Virginia PTA Leadership Team can happen in various ways that could be within your interest and skills, in order to support West Virginia PTA. You might be new to the state level and are interested in exploring leadership opportunities or would like to work on a specific project or committee. BOARD OF MANAGERS POSITIONS

Additional information about Board of Managers positions:

Other than the elected officers and at-large member, all Board of Managers positions are appointed by the President and approved by the Executive Committee for two (2) year terms. Each person approved will serve as the Chairperson of their committee and will work on various projects to further the mission and strategic plan of the West Virginia PTA. All Board of Managers positions have a vote on the West Virginia PTA. As voting members, you are required to attend West Virginia PTA Board of Managers meetings, which are typically held in July, October, January, and the annual convention. At meetings, you will report to the Board on the work your committees have completed. Your committees may not always be able to meet in person due to volunteers participating from all over the state. Therefore, you may need to communicate by video or telephone conferencing or email communications to complete the necessary work of your committee.

ARTS IN EDUCATION CHAIR – Shall chair the Arts in Education Committee. The committee will promote and encourage involvement in the arts and will coordinate the West Virginia PTA Reflections program. The responsibilities of the committee also include keeping informed of issues concerning fine arts and distributing information to the membership. The Arts in Education Committee will also encourage observance of programs such as Music in Our Schools and Youth Art Month.

<u>CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS AND DISABILITIES CHAIR</u> – Shall coordinate workshops throughout West Virginia to promote the Special Artists Division of the National PTA Reflections program. They will provide information to the marketing committee for the State PTA website to give additional resources to these families and will serve on the legislative committee to support initiatives for children with special needs and disabilities.

MARKETING/PUBLIC RELATIONS CHAIR – Shall chair the Marketing Committee. The committee will be responsible for the bi-monthly bulletin, resource library, website, and social media content including Facebook and Pinterest in collaboration with the President. The objectives of the Marketing Committee are to strengthen the visibility of the PTA and to enhance communication from West Virginia PTA to local unit members.

<u>CONVENTION CHAIR</u> – Shall chair the Convention Committee and will be the point person for the planning of the Annual West Virginia PTA Convention in 2016 and 2017. This is a highly anticipated event for PTA members throughout the state to receive training, conduct the business of the Association, visit with vendors and network with individuals across West Virginia.

EXTENSION CHAIR – Shall chair the Extension Committee and will be responsible for development of the annual Extension Plan which identifies priorities and works to bring PTA into communities through West Virginia that are underserved by PTA. The Extension Plan identifies priorities and goals for yearly progress and is approved by the Board and submitted to National PTA. The chair will also oversee the Passport to Leadership Program. Regional directors will also serve on this committee.



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HEALTH AND SAFETY CHAIR – Shall chair the Health and Safety Committee which will be responsible for the Student Healthy Recipe Contest and supporting other National PTA family-oriented programs including Healthy Lifestyles Month, Fuel Up to Play 60, Kids Cook Monday, and Improving Energy Balance. The responsibilities of the committee include keeping PTA members informed of issues concerning health and safety, childhood obesity, physical activity, food allergies, as well as distributing information in an appropriate manner to the membership.

OFFICE COORDINATOR – Shall be responsible for day-to-day operations of the West Virginia PTA office in Parkersburg.

PARENT AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT CHAIR – Shall chair the Parent and Family Engagement Committee and will be responsible for supporting the PTA Standards for Family-School Partnerships. The Chair will work closely with the committee to promote male involvement and support parent and family engagement programs endorsed by National PTA including the PTA MORE Alliance (Men Organized to Raise Engagement). The committee will also work to promote Take Your Family to School Week, Family Reading Experience powered by Kindle, and foster parent and family engagement ideas to our local units.

<u>REGIONAL DIRECTORS</u> – Shall provide direct services to local units and are the link between the state and the local PTA. Regional Directors provide resources, and help local leaders and units with their needs. They will also be responsible for any and all trainings provided to local units in collaboration with the President.

RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT CHAIR – Shall serve as chair of the Resource Development Committee and will be responsible for identifying new funding sources for West Virginia PTA through non-dues revenue such as donors, endowment fund, and/or grants. By identifying new funding for the Association, the committee will ensure the future of the West Virginia PTA.

<u>SCHOLARSHIP CHAIR</u> – Shall coordinate the WV PTA Scholarship program and chair the Scholarship Committee consisting of Board of Managers members. The Chair will be in charge of the annual scholarship auction held at the state convention which raises funds for the West Virginia PTA scholarship fund.

YOUTH MEMBER – Shall chair the Youth Involvement Committee. Please contact the West Virginia PTA Office for detailed information and application.

SPECIAL COMMITTEES

Additional Information about Special Committees:

Special Committees are additional committees that work with Board of Managers members on various projects to further the mission and Strategic Plan of the West Virginia PTA. Committee members are not required to attend West Virginia PTA Board of Managers meetings and they do not have a vote on the Board. Their work can be done on the individuals own time and simply report to the appropriate chairperson of their committee. Committee meetings may be held by video or telephone conferencing, or by email communications set forth by the individual committee chair. This is a wonderful opportunity to use your strengths in these areas to contribute to West Virginia PTA without needing to attend Board meetings!

EDUCATIONAL/FINANCIAL OUTREACH COMMITTEE – The objectives of the Educational and Financial Outreach Committee are to identify scholarships that are available to West Virginia students and provide information to the Communications Chair for the West Virginia PTA website. Chaired by the Treasurer, the committee will provide information about financial programs in West Virginia, such as SMART 529, and any programs which support higher education and financial assistance opportunities for our students.

HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE – The objective of the Historical Preservation Committee is to preserve the history of West Virginia PTA. This committee may include past PTA presidents and Board of Managers members that will collect valuable pieces of our history and share insight and information about West Virginia PTA at our annual convention.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE – The objectives of the Legislative Committee are to provide advocacy for the PTA public policy program at the local, state and national levels. Chaired by the President-Elect, this committee develops resolutions for consideration by the membership and advocates for the policies of PTA. The Special Needs Chair serves on this committee.

YOUTH INVOLVEMENT COMMITTEE – The Youth Involvement Committee is comprised of youth in grades 6-12 who are interested in promoting the importance of students in the role of PTA's today. The West Virginia PTA Board of Managers will gain a new perspective for program development, as well as acquire a better understanding of the youth of today by listening to ideas and suggestions presented by this committee. This will provide these students the opportunity to make a difference by developing leadership skills, learning about the legislative process and increasing their self-esteem by our supporting their contributions to West Virginia.
