## West Virginia PTA forms the "WV Coalition for Public Education"

West Virginia PTA's mission is to make every child's potential a reality by engaging and empowering families and communities to advocate for all children. They have dedicated over 90 years toward bettering the lives of every child in education, health and safety and continue to be a powerful voice for all children, and a strong advocate for public education.

To effectively realize their mission, the College and Career Readiness Team of the West Virginia PTA is forming a coalition between the many organizations in our state that support a quality public education for our students. This new coalition will be comprised of civic, civil rights, child advocacy and education organizations that represent over 280,000 students statewide. The coalition will support public education and will oppose the expenditure of public funds to support private and religious schools through mechanisms such as tuition vouchers, tax credits and other types of vouchers.

West Virginia PTA will be hosting an event on Friday, September 22, 2017, at 8 am, at Fairmont State University, to officially announce the establishment of the West Virginia Coalition for Public Education. At this event, a representative from each organization joining the group will be participating in an official "coalition signing". With support from the West Virginia Department of Education, the PTA believes there is strength in numbers and the more organizations involved in making their voices heard, the better our public education system will be. "I commend the West Virginia PTA for taking the initiative to bring together such a diverse group of stakeholder organizations who are commonly bound by the goal of providing the best possible education for all West Virginia students," said West Virginia Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Steven Paine.
