National PTA "Stop Cuts to Classrooms" campaign is extended!

The deadline to fund the federal government was extended to December 8, 2018. Therefore, National PTA has decided to extend the #STOPCutsToClassrooms campaign to December 8 to continue to spread the message and advocate for greater federal investments in public education. PTA members nationwide made their voices heard through social media to #STOPCutsToClassrooms from July through September amounting to millions of shared posts to raise awareness of the critical need to invest in federal education programs. As Congress is still working to fund the government for next year, we too still have a job to do as PTA advocates to ensure every child receives a quality education and reaches their full potential.
