## Keynote Speaker, Rev. Dr. David Artman -

## Directions to Subiaco Abbey 405 N. Subiaco, Subiaco, AR

### From I-40 Westbound:

Take I40 West to Russellville exit #81 (AR Highway 7). Turn LEFT on access road and then LEFT onto AR Hwy 7. Go approximately 7 miles and take a SLIGHT RIGHT onto AR 22/AR 155 – stay on AR Highway 22 – approximately 28 miles. Turn RIGHT on N. Thomas Avenue. Turn LEFT on N. Subiaco Avenue. The Abbey will be on your right.



### From I-40 Eastbound:

Take I40 East to Ozark Exit 37 (AR Highway 219) Turn RIGHT on AR 219/ N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and go approximately 1.8 miles. Turn RIGHT on W. Commercial Street (AR 219), then LEFT on S. 7<sup>th</sup> Street (AR 23). Stay on AR 23 for approximately 1.5 miles. Turn LEFT on AR 309 just past Ferry Road. Stay RIGHT at the fork and continue on AR 309. Take the first LEFT to stay on AR 309 for another 9.6 miles. Turn LEFT on E. Walnut Street (AR 22) – stay on AR 22 for approximately 5.4 miles. Turn LEFT on N. Subiaco Avenue. The Abbey will be on your left.
