Why is it important to complete this form?

Having your officer's current information helps us keep you informed of vital information you need about resources, programs, awards, incentives, and much more!

Do I need to fill it out if our officers stayed the same?

Each year we need to ensure we have the most accurate information for all PTA's, even if your information didn't change. We want to make sure you receive everything you need to run your unit successfully!

What if we have a mid-year change?

Just notify us with our on-line form! Simply go to the link and update the information. It's that easy!

West Virginia PTA maintains all of the essential filings for your PTA! Through our Standards of Affiliation, all local units have a central location to ensure you are meeting federal guidelines as a 501(c)(3) entity.

Each local unit or county council PTA must be in good standing with West Virginia PTA to continue to operate as a PTA and as a tax---exempt organization. In order to remain in good standing, West Virginia PTA requires six easy steps to ensure your PTA is compliant:

- Submit the annual Local Unit Officer Form (now online!);
- Submit membership dues monthly, with a payment of a minimum of ten members by October 1 of each year;
- Submit an annual review/audit of the PTA's financial records;
- Submit a copy of the annual 990 form or e-postcard;
- Submit proof of your bonding and liability insurance (if your PTA uses AIM, your information is provided automatically by AIM); and
- Submit bylaws for approval every three years.

Being in good standing is easy! It is our goal at West Virginia PTA to ensure that your PTA is running effectively and within the requirements of the government. Please use the chart below to track your Standards of Affiliation. You may direct all questions to info@westvirginiapta.org.
