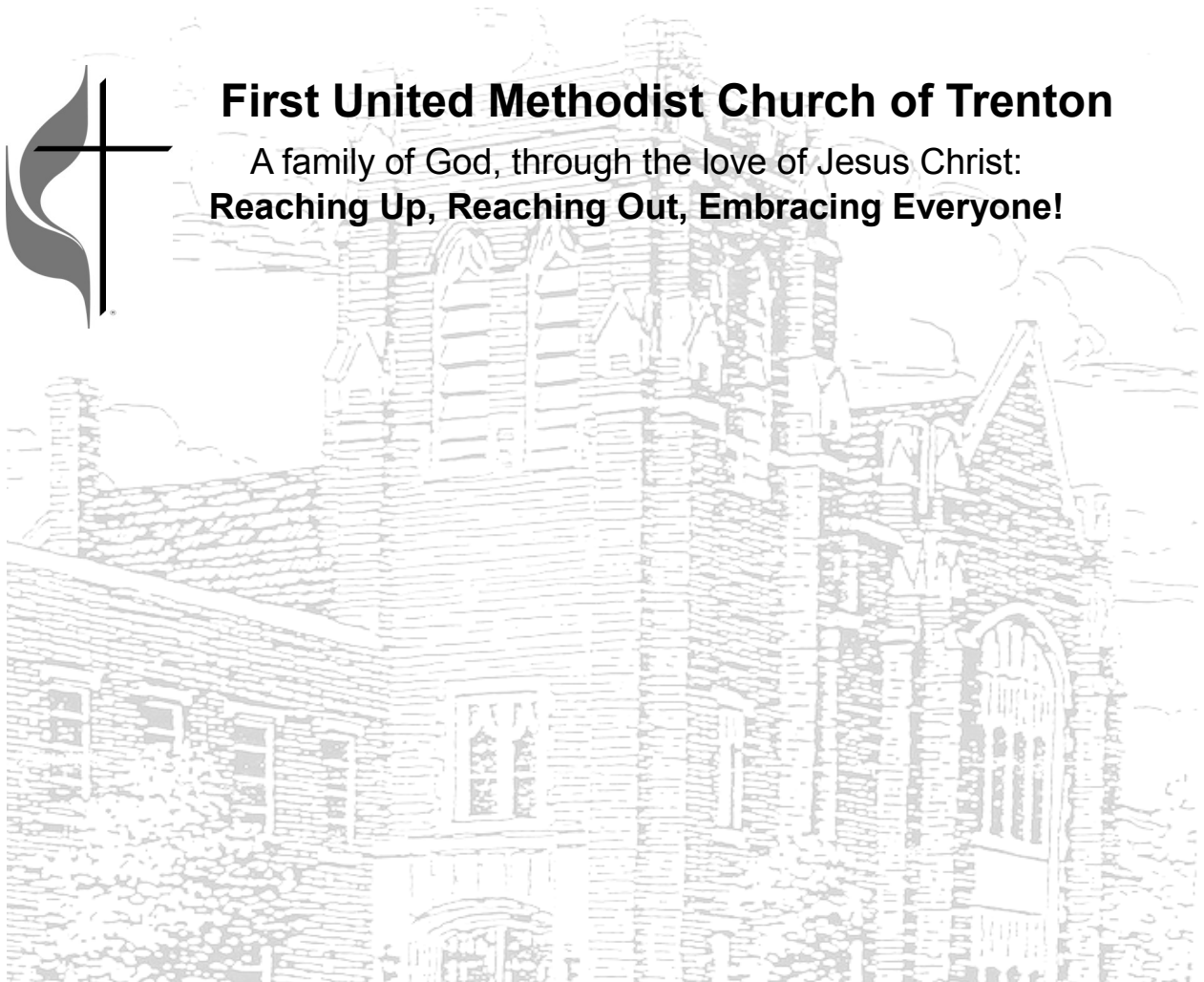

St. Mary's Catholic Church in Rockwood will be hosting and staffing the ChristNet Rotating Homeless Shelter here at First UMC this week.

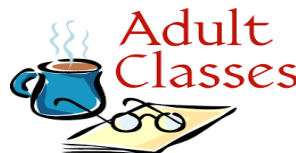
