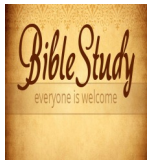


### Breakfast & Devotion

### St. Philip's Food Pantry

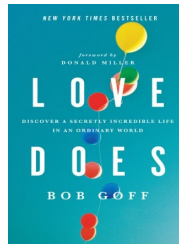
