CONDITIONS

EXTENSION WILL BE GRANTED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

Except as otherwise provided by law or in NRSA Ordinance 2004-1 and as amended by Ordinance 2008-1, the owners of a single-family dwelling on property having private on-site sewage disposal shall connect to the public sewer within two years of the date of availability. This period is referred to as the "two-year connection period."

The Authority shall approve such applications upon satisfactory demonstration by the owner that the on-site system is properly functioning. The Authority may base its determination on documentation of inspections and maintenance, and may require an inspection including a site visit, solids level test, dye test or internal plumbing inspection, at the owner's cost.

Subject to NRSA Board of Director's approval, the owner may apply for an additional extension, subject to the limitation that connection to the public sewer must be made within five (5) years of the date of availability. In no case involving property with private on-site sewage disposal shall the time for connection be extended beyond a date 5 (five) years following the date of availability, including the two-year connection period.

Until actual connection to the public sewer system, sewage disposal on such Premises shall be Private Sewage Disposal according to Section 3, and the owner of the premises shall be responsible for all costs associated with installation, repair and maintenance of the private sewer disposal system, and pumping and transportation of sewage required by law.
