

# Order of the Mass #140

## 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Entrance Antiphon:** "O Lord, hear my voice, for I have called to you; be my help. Do not abandon or forsake me, O God, my Savior!" Cf. Ps 27 (26): 7, 9

**Communion Antiphon:** "There is one thing I ask of the Lord, only this do I seek: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life." Ps 27 (26): 4

**Reflection for this Sunday:** The 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time invites us to reflect on God's faithful love, His mercy toward sinners, and His call for us to become active disciples in the world. In the first reading, God reminds the Israelites how He rescued them from slavery, carried them through the desert, and called them to live as His treasured people by keeping His covenant. Obedience to God is not simply about following rules; it is a loving response to the One who has first loved, protected, and guided us. In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us of the radical mercy of God: Christ died for us while we were still sinners. God does not wait for us to become perfect before loving us; He reaches out to forgive, heal, and bring us back to life. In the Gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowds with compassion because they are troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. He then sends His disciples to preach, heal, and serve. This same mission continues today. Each of us is called to share the love we have received—not only through words, but through kindness, forgiveness, prayer, service, and a life that reflects Christ. This Sunday reminds us that faith is not meant to remain hidden in the heart; it must become obedience, trust, compassion, and action. God continues to call us to be His chosen people and His instruments of mercy in the world.
