## Changes in Seasonal Activities

Brush and leaves will continue to be picked up through October. Then our machinery is changed in anticipation of winter. On the FIRST MONDAY of October brush will be collected. Please do not stack the brush too high (under one foot) and put the butt ends toward the road. On the THIRD MONDAY of October leaves will be collected. Yard waste must be in biodegradable/compostable bags (no regular plastic trash bags accepted). Brown paper yard waste bags and/or "Bag to Nature" 100% compostable plastic bags are available at Wal-Mart, Lowe's, Menard's, etc. Stack bags and brush at your curb. Please be considerate of our maintenance worker by loading bags that one person can easily carry. PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR ITEMS TO THE MAINTENANCE BUILDING OR ANY OTHER VILLAGE SITE—VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED.

New horseshoe pits have been constructed at Latimer Park. Bring your own horseshoes and play some games!




