Present Streets

After some discussion by the board it was decided to get bids on all three projects to present at the next meeting.

Sediment Sample

Korpal present a bid for \$11,000 from Cliff Young to do the sediment sample. The board decided that we should get more bids to see if it can be done cheaper. Ron Irwin stated that Austin should call PLM to see if they would do it. Henry Petersen stated that he has the number for the new engineer from Fleis and Vandenbrink and would provide that to Austin.

Boards response to Petersens grievance from the March meeting

New Business:

Non homestead Tax- Ashlee

Feliciano brought a proposal for a non-homestead tax in the Village of Morley. There was some discussion about this matter. Weed stated that he needed more information about it. It was decided that we would look into the number of houses that are not homesteaded so we can get a rough estimate of the extra income it would bring to the Village of Morley.

Purchase of Maintenance tools

Korpal stated that the Village needs a pressure washer and battery charger for the maintenance worker to be able to clean our vehicles and maintain them properly. The Village used to have one but that was many years ago and it is no longer working.

Petersen motioned to spend up to \$1200 dollars for these pieces of equipment. She asked that Austin send options to the board via text to choose from. Weed seconded this motion.

Public Questions & Comments:

- Jim Lewis recommended that the Village purchase a pressure washer that has a heat setting. Korpal stated that he would look into this.
- Eleanor Holland asked if something could be done about people driving too fast coming into the Alley by her house because she has grandkids that play in her yard and people are cutting into her yard. Korpal stated that this Alley is one that is not used except for by people using it as a driveway. Korpal also stated that the Village needs to clean up the edge of the Alley so that people are not driving over into Mrs Hollands' yard. Petersen mentioned disbanding the alley and Korpal stated he would call the attorney about that process.
- Shane Shaw asked the Village Council for conditional approval of his dispensary so he could begin construction on the building being used for his dispensary.

Petersen made the motion seconded by Feliciano.
