Thank you for Joining us for our first Annual Tree Lighting. We had so much fun decorating cookies and staying warm with our hot beverages. Thank you for all that participated!!

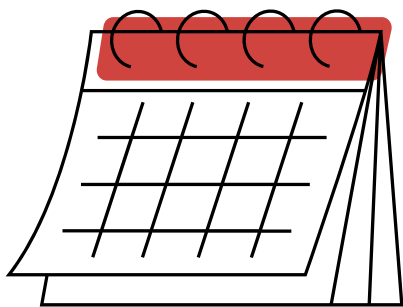
