Some projects that the Village is hoping to accomplish this summer are paving 7th Street by the Morley Community Center, East Street from 7th to 9th street, and 9th Street from East Street to Cass Street. The Village is also hoping to get much needed work done on the Frank Deyo Dam to be compliant with what EGLE is requesting from the Village of Morley.

On March 9 at the Village's regularly scheduled council meeting the Village Council authorized Village President, Austin Korpala, to apply for federal funding for the 2027 fiscal year in hopes of dredging the Morley Pond, funding more Dam repairs, and installing a board walk behind the businesses along the alleyway.

Celebration on the Pond has some exciting events coming up for our community!

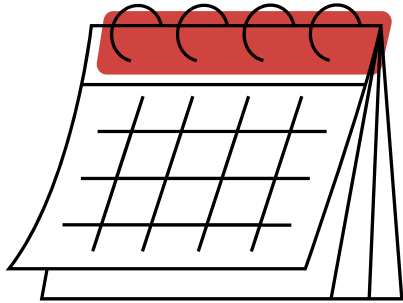
May 9 is a mom-prom ladie's night taking place at the American Legion.
