

ORDINANCE NO. 44

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

THE VILLAGE OF MORLEY HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Rules and Regulations. No person shall transport or possess any alcoholic liquor in any container which is open, uncapped, or which has a broken seal, in any public park or grounds (i.e. Celebration Acres) which is open to the public.

Section 2. Exceptions.

A. This Ordinance does not in any way restrict businesses that are licensed by the State of Michigan to sell alcoholic liquor.

B. Other exceptions may be made on an individual basis with a special resolution of the Village Board by a majority vote of the Board Members present at any appropriate Morley Village Board Meeting.

Section 3. Penalty. Violation of this Ordinance is a civil infraction and shall be punishable by a fine of at least one hundred (\$100.00) dollars but not more than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars plus the court costs.


Section 4. Conflicting Provisions. In the event of any conflicting provisions between this ordinance and a prior Ordinance, the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication in a news paper of general circulation in the Village of Morley.


