VILLAGE ORDINANCE # 29

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation owning, keeping, harboring or having charge of any dog or dogs to suffer or permit such dog or dogs to run at large within the Village of Morley.

Section 2. No person shall own, harbor or keep any dog, which by loud or frequent barking, howling or yelping, becomes a nuisance in the neighborhood, in which such dog is so kept.

Section 3. No person shall own, harbor, or keep any dog, whether licensed or unlicensed, that by destruction of property or trespassing on others property, becomes a nuisance in the neighborhood, in which the dog is so kept.

Section 4. No person shall be convicted under the provisions of Section #2 and #3 except upon evidence of four (4) or more persons of different households.

Section 5. The Village Marshall shall have full power to enforce the above ordinances. The Village Marshall shall have full power to collect fees specified below:

Two dollars (\$2.00) fee for pick up of the dog.
Fifty cents (\$.50) per day. Not to exceed five (5) days.
If the dog is not called for within five (5) days,
the dog will be disposed of.

PARKING

Two (2) hour parking on Cass Street and Fourth Street will be enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

The above ordinances become effective March 1, 1957.
