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EVENT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS & CIS SITE COORDINATORS

I. Registration

- a. Participants must be enrolled in Communities In Schools
- b. Participants must complete and return a signed Participant Registration Form to their campus Site Coordinator.
- c. Signed *Participant Registration Forms* must be submitted to the CIS Central Office by April 10, 2020. Limit of 35 participants per campus. (First come, first served)
- d. Participants will receive a nametag from their CIS Site Coordinator once registration is approved.
- e. Nametags must be worn by each participant for the entire event.
- f. CIS Staff will be contacted when name tags are ready for pick-up from Central Office.
- g. Nametags must be returned to the Central Office within 72 hours after the event.

II. Safety & Security

- a. Killeen Independent School District (KISD) Security Officer(s) will be on the premises during this event.
- b. Each CIS Site Coordinator will work to ensure the safety of all event participants during the event.
- c. Parents/Guardians will be responsible for coordinating their student participant's arrival and departure to and from the event location.
- d. To ensure participant safety, spectators including parents/guardians will not be allowed in the student participant stands with athletes.

III. Equipment

- a. Starting blocks will not be available.
- b. Sacks will be provided for the sack race.
- c. Tennis shoes/sneakers are required.
- d. Spiked/metal cleats are **NOT** allowed.

IV. Tug-O-War

- a. This will be the first event to take place.
- b. Bracketed event.
- c. Sign-up is *by campus*.
- d. All participants must be present at the start of the competition.
- e. Middle schools may have up to five (5) participants.
 - i. If a team fields fewer than five (5) students, they will have to compete with fewer students than other teams.
- f. Elementary schools may have up to ten (10) participants.
 - i. If a team fields fewer than 10 students, they will have to compete with fewer students than other teams.
- g. Participants can only compete with their assigned campus.
- h. One elementary school campus champion will receive a trophy.
- i. One middle school campus champion will receive a trophy.

V. Running Events

- a. Participants will compete by grade and gender.
- b. Races will begin with the 400-Meter Dash.
- c. The final race will be the 50-Meter Dash.



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VI. Long Jump

- a. Each athlete is allowed 2 jumps.
- b. Longest jump will be recorded.
- c. Jump is measured where the heel lands.
- d. If there is a tie, there will be a jump off.

VII. Point/Scoring System

- a. Points are not awarded by each race finish time.
- b. Points are awarded by overall event grade and gender finish times.
 - i. 1st Place (3 points)
 - ii. 2nd Place (2 points)
 - iii. 3rd Place (1 points)

VIII. Overall point totals:

- a. Top three elementary schools will receive a trophy.
- b. Top three middle schools will receive a trophy.

IX. Awards

- a. Once student participant times are entered into the system, awards will be distributed. Normally, within one week. All athletes will receive certificates and participation ribbons.
- b. Top three performers in **each** grade level will receive certificates and either 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place ribbons.

X. Volunteers

- a. All volunteers must undergo a school district background check. No exceptions.
- b. Volunteers must also complete and submit a CIS Volunteer Application by Wednesday, April 10, 2020.
- c. Volunteers will be provided with a "color of the day" wristband by the campus Site Coordinator.
- d. Wristbands must be worn for the entirety of the event.

XI. Refreshments

- a. All food must be brought in to the event at the time of arrival.
- b. No food deliveries will be permitted at the event.
- c. Food and drink will be provided to athletes by their respective CIS Site Coordinator(s) and campus volunteer(s).
- d. Only water is allowed on the field.
- e. Water buffalos will be stationed at opposite ends of the field.
- f. Concession stand will be available to anyone with money.
- g. Outside food and drinks will not be allowed on track or field.
- h. There will be a labeled designated area in the stands for each participating campus.
- i. CIS Site Coordinators and their campus volunteers will be responsible for clean-up of the stands and grounds at the conclusion of the event.
