Nina arrived on campus like a storm. She shouted that she'd been kidnapped, shouted insults at anyone nearby, and ran whenever she saw an opportunity. Every day felt like a test she was determined to fail.

But months passed, and the storm quieted.

One afternoon over lunch, a staff member finally asked the question everyone had been wondering: *What changed?*

Nina didn't hesitate. "I didn't trust you," she said. "So, I tried to push you away. I thought if I made you angry enough, you'd let me leave. But you didn't. You showed me you loved me. And even when you were hard on me, I realized it was because you wanted what was best for me. I realized I could trust you."

That honesty revealed the truth behind her transformation. The girl who once fought every rule now offered kindness freely. She listened. She helped. She respected boundaries. She became almost unrecognizable from the child who first walked through the door.
