Urgent for Guatemala—6/4-5/18 "We thank the Lord that our Alliance churches have not been affected nor have major consequences from the eruption of the Fuego volcano," Rev. Marco Antonio Rodriguez, president of The Alliance in Guatemala, reported. "However, the danger is still a concern in places surrounding the volcano. One of our churches, Galilee village church of Guadalupe El Zapote Escuintla, is located exactly in the volcanic line." At this writing, the death toll is 69 and expected to rise. At least 500 have been injured, and more than 2 million people have been affected in some way. "Our church in San Lucas has opened a collection center to receive aid for the victims in the places surrounding the Fuego volcano," said Rev. Rodriguez. "The volcano continues its activity with less intensity, but the risk of flooding remains because we are in the winter and there is a large amount of volcanic sand above, which can be washed away by the rain currents, which will cause rivers to overflow."


