Intercede also for M, the crisis pregnancy shelter director, as she reaches out to these women and attends an intensive Christian counseling program while working to establish the center's policies and procedures. Pray that God will send a compassionate woman to serve as a house mom and role model for these young women once the shelter opens.

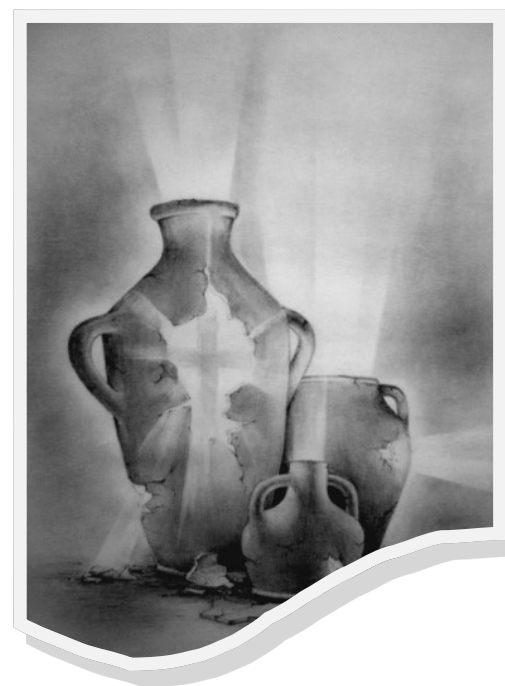
