PRAYER IS PRIMARY

Memorial Day evening, 13 confirmed tornadoes ripped through the Greater Dayton Area in southwest Ohio, leaving one person dead & more than 200 injured; at least 40 homes were damaged or destroyed, according to news reports. One of the hardest hit areas was Trotwood, a northwest suburb. Governor Mike Dewine declared a state of emergency in three Ohio counties in Dayton on Tuesday, May 28. CAMA Services, the Ohio Valley District, & Dayton Area Alliance churches—along with the Red Cross, Samaritan's Purse, & the Dayton Emergency Management Agency—are assisting in disaster relief efforts. Fifty \$50 Walmart gift cards were distributed by our two Alliance pastors to their neighbors whose homes were damaged by the tornado. The staff of Fairhaven Church is assisting Samaritan's Purse in clearing debris in devastated areas. Alliance churches are helping to provide food & water to people staying at area Red Cross shelters. Local Alliance churches are sending work teams to help with relief efforts; CAMA, the Ohio Valley District, and Dayton area Alliance churches are raising funds to help with these efforts. Phil Lohmeyer, CAMA's coordinator for Disaster Response Ministries, will assess the devastation & help Alliance churches with a long-term, strategic disaster relief plan. Please pray for all affected by this disaster.
