Republic of Congo: To reduce the proliferation of false sects and confidence schemes posing as churches, the government is requiring that to be officially recognized, every church must have a permanent building and a pastor who has a recognized theological certificate. This has been a hardship to some Alliance congregations that have not yet been able to erect their church buildings. **Pray especially** for the churches in Ollombo and Mboukou that do not yet have money for completing their buildings. **On a more positive note**, the result of the government requirement for theological training is that in Brazzaville and Pointe-Noire, government inspectors have been steering untrained pastors to the Alliance Bible Institute, housed at the C&MA's two Christian Study Centers. **Praise the Lord** for the gospel. *Pray for a swift resolution to some staffing needs for the study center so registrations for the coming year will begin smoothly*.




