

WEST AFRICA: This week, the first two positive cases of the coronavirus passed through an Alliance-affiliated hospital. For the moment, the government is treating these patients in specialized centers around the country, so neither case is still in the Alliance facility. Please pray for several aspects of this situation: 1) Pray for two national staff members who had contact with the cases. Some were not wearing proper protective material, & so they have been asked to self-isolate. 2) Intercede for hospital leaders as the hospital receives these kinds of cases. Government hospitals are not making it easy to get patients transferred to where they should be, meaning added stress to Alliance doctors and staff. 3) Pray for International Workers taking the lead in diagnosing & doing initial treatment on these patients, especially Dr. S., who just happens to be from our district.
