Oct 19, 2020...URGENT PRAYER REQUEST...Since early October, heavy rains, sometimes two—three times a day, have resulted in massive flooding in many parts of Cambodia. In addition to continuous rains, a major dam broke last week, causing floods throughout all of Battambang province. According to the latest report, the Cambodian government has closed four national highways until further notice. Currently, at least nine provinces are severely affected by the floods. A majority of the Cambodian populace are rice and plantation farmers; they were anticipating an abundant harvest time around the end of October into early November. But now, with most rice paddies completely under water, there may not be a harvest this year. Ask God for a miracle! According to Alliance workers Syna and Soeuth Lao, flooding also brings snakes, which often crawl into stilted huts where people and their domestic animals reside. Even after the water recedes, there will be high risks for mosquito-transmitted diseases such as dengue fever, malaria, and more serious ailments. In response to the immediate need, the Laos and their partners organized a rice distribution to about 130 families who are severely affected by the floods. *Please cover this entire situation in prayer*.


