

Cedarville Township Volunteer Fire Department Vehicle Operator Requirements 2019

New Driver Certification:

1. Must have valid drivers license.
2. Be rider trained on vehicle.
3. Complete map test for both Cedarville village and township.
4. Complete EVOG (as / when offered)
5. Complete drivers training with a department member or officer.
6. Be verified by a second officer on driving road test
7. Complete driving maneuverability test** with a department officer

Current Driver Recertification:

1. Must be recertified on every vehicle a current driver of.
2. Responsible to keep own log of driving time.
3. Need minimum of two hours road time on each vehicle per year.
4. If time requirement achieved, will not have to take driving road test.
5. If time requirement not achieved, must do driving road test* with an officer.
6. Driving maneuverability test** will be completed on largest vehicle qualified to operate.

* Driving road test will be predetermined route to incorporate NFPA standard.

** Driving maneuverability test will consist of NFPA standard obstacle course.

Anytime a member receives a traffic violation, the Chief will be notified on what the citation was issued for.

All members shall carry an insurance policy on their personal vehicle. A current copy of insurance and drivers license shall be given to the Chief to be kept on file. Any changes in information shall be noted to the Chief.
