Propane grill use policy
2017

1. The Cedarville Fireman's Association propane cooking grill shall only be used for Cedarville Fireman's Association or Cedarville Township Volunteer Fire Department purposes. The grill shall not be used for personal use. Any other organizations wishing to use the grill may do so with permission from the Cedarville Fireman's Association President or Vice President.
2. Cedarville Fireman's Association member or members performing the cooking shall be responsible for the use, care, and clean up of the grill.
 - A. Cooking surface should be brushed clean with supplied cleaning tool.
 - B. Stainless steel surface should be wiped down with soap and water.
 - C. Propane bottle is to be turned off when not in use.
 - D. Drip pan for grease should be emptied and cleaned as needed.
 - E. Cover should be placed on grill when hood is cool to the touch
 - F. Grill should be returned to storage location behind generator in bay
 - G. Empty propane bottle should be exchanged at the Cedarville Village Market under the Cedarville Fireman's Association house charge.
3. All other inquiries should be directed to the Cedarville Fireman's Association President or Vice President.
