

Lot Rent Increase:

To all residents of Arlington Woods, For the upcoming year, our monthly lot rent increase will be \$15 beginning on January 1, 2025.

This increase is necessary to keep our community locally owned and operated as well as cover the increased costs to maintain the community.

We believe we provide the best value of any manufactured community in Muskegon County and will continue to do so providing our rents are closely comparable to surrounding communities.

Holiday Trash:

During the week of January 1st, 2025, trash pick up for the New Year's Day holiday will run 1 day behind schedule. Please place your trash can out on Wednesday evening for a Thursday pick up.

Trash Carts & Snow:

All trash cans put out on pick up day will need to be placed several feet from the road during the winter months. We do not want the plow trucks to damage them. Please keep in mind that the garbage truck arms are only able to reach 9 feet so please do not place your trash can too far from the road.

Prevent Snow Plow Damage:

What Kind of Damage Can Snowplows Cause? Due to their massive size and power, there are many different ways a snowplow could damage your property.

- Edges of Property: The edges of your property are the most vulnerable to snowplow damages. Plows can dig into the ground, causing sections of the lawn to be lifted up or be removed entirely.
- Sprinklers: In ground sprinklers are usually placed along the edges of the lawn leaving them open to being hit by snowplows, rendering them useless.
- Mailboxes: Snowplows can end up hitting mailboxes at the end of the driveway because they can't see them, causing them to knock down or destroy completely.
- Corner Posts and Yard Decor: Corner posts and Yard Decor that is placed too close to the road are at risk of getting hit by a snowplow. Preventing Snowplow Damage to Your Property There are several ways to prevent different kinds of damages to your property from snowplows.
- Mark Edges of Lawn: Make it easier for snowplow drivers to see the edge of your lawn by putting brightly colored wooden stakes along the edges. Drivers are less likely to plow over your lawn if the edges are clearly marked.
- Mark Irrigation Sprinkler Heads: While you are marking the edges of your territory, add in some wooden stakes near your sprinkler heads as well for extra protection against snowplow damage.
- Relocate the Mailbox: Make sure your mailbox is not too close to the road.
- Relocate or Remove Corner Posts and Yard Decor: Remove yard decor and or corner posts to an appropriate area when it snows so snowplow drivers can clear up as much of the road as possible without damaging your items.

Winter Parking:

Please remember to park your vehicles on your off- street parking pad during winter months. Street parking from midnight to 7:00 am is prohibited. Any vehicles parked in the street are in violation of this rule and will be towed at the owners' expense without warning. Street parking during heavy winter storms is also prohibited. Management normally plows during the early morning hours (3am-7am). Vehicles parked in the street make it impossible to plow properly. We appreciate all of your cooperation with this.

Homes On Corner Lots or Close To Roads:

If you are a homeowner that resides at one of the corner lots or if your home is located close to one of our community roads, please reinforce your skirting with boards so that your skirting doesn't sustain damage from the snowplows during the winter months. Please do this in a neat & orderly fashion. Arlington Woods is not liable for snowplow damage done to your home while they are out plowing the roads.

Remove yard decor and or corner posts to an appropriate area when it snows so snowplow drivers can clear up as much of the road as possible without damaging your items.

Heat Tape Explained:

"Heat tape" for mobile homes is a specialized electrical cable that is wrapped around exterior water pipes to prevent them from freezing during cold weather, essentially functioning as a heating element to keep the water flowing by maintaining a temperature above freezing; it's commonly used in mobile homes because of their potential for exposed plumbing vulnerable to freezing temperatures, and is typically installed in crawl spaces or under the mobile home's structure where pipes run along exterior walls.

Winter Reminders:

- Keep roof vents clear of ice & snow.
- Check the heat tape under your home to be sure it is in proper working order.
- Have all skirting in place to protect pipes.
- Let your water stream on cold days/nights to avoid pipes from freezing.
- Be sure any exposed outside pipes are wrapped and covered with a box.
- Please do not shovel snow into the streets.

The Bureau of Construction Codes is excited to announce that we now have a dedicated mobile home community inspection team. Moving forward, annual inspections will be conducted by one of our four regulation officers assigned solely to mobile home community inspections. Our goal is for this highly talented and effective team to be a direct point of contact for you and work collaboratively to help mobile home communities maintain compliance with state of Michigan standards.

As a courtesy we wanted to provide a list of common concerns the regulation officers are finding during their annual inspection visits.

- Uncapped sewer pipes
- Uncapped holes for water hookup
- Exposed electrical wires
- Unsecured electrical boxes
- · Unlocked gas valves
- · Debris/rubbish/garbage throughout the park including occupied lots
- Missing skirting around homes
- Lots (vacant and occupied) not being clearly labeled
- Water drainage issues
- · Signs of rodent and/or insect infestations

Please note, this list is not all inclusive as to what the team is looking at and other items may be noted during inspections, including general health and safety concerns.

Resident Updates:

Please remember to keep your account information updated regularly. Emails, phone numbers, vehicles and places of employment are some examples of the information that the office struggles to keep updated. We cannot contact you if we do not have the correct information on your account.

Rent & Terms:

Rent is due on the first day of each month.

On the 9th day of the current month, a one time per month late fee of \$25.00 will be added to the rent account of the tardy resident.

We accept checks, money order, online payments through our Tenant Web Access or you may sign up for auto withdraw (a form must be completed in the office).

A \$25.00 Charge will be added to your rent account for any check or auto withdraw that is returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

An additional charge of \$5.00 per month is made if you have an approved animal living in your home.

Mow Fee Increase:

Effective January 1, 2025 the mow fee for Arlington to maintain your lawn should you be in violation of not mowing your own lawn will increase from \$50 to \$75.

Drop Box:

A drop box is located on the front of the office, to the right of the front entrance door, and can be used to pay rent or for other communication with staff and is available for use at all times.

Title Requirements:

All homes in Arlington Woods must be owner occupied, this is done by placing the home in your name at the time of purchase and providing the title to our office at the time of lease signing.

When selling your home, it is a requirement that the title be in the name of the buyer prior to them moving in, taking possession and signing their lease. What this means for you: It is the responsibility of the buyer and seller to properly transfer the title with the Secretary of State at the time of sale. The current lease holder (seller) will be responsible for the home, lot and rent until the qualified buyer signs the lease and presents the title in their name.

Speed Limit:

BY STATE LAW, THE SPEED LIMIT IN MANUFACTURED HOUSING COMMUNITIES IS 15-MILES PER HOUR. A habitual speeder who refuses to change his/her habits could be evicted for violating the speed limit after being warned in writing three times. Residents are held fully responsible for the speed at which their guest travel while on community property.
