

LOT RENT INCREASE:

Subject: Adjustment to Monthly Lot Rent and Commitment to Community Investment - Effective January 1, 2026

This letter provides 30 days' formal written notice regarding an essential adjustment to the monthly lot rent.

Effective January 1, 2026 the basic monthly lot rent for all lots will increase from \$460.00 to \$475.00, for an increase of \$15.00. We expect another increase in July 2026 of an additional \$15.00.

We understand a significant adjustment like this impacts your household budget, and we want to be fully transparent about the necessity and the direct benefit of this change. This decision was made after an extensive review of escalating operational costs and the needs of our community infrastructure and to stay competitive with the other communities in our area.

The primary drivers for this necessary adjustment are to keep the community locally owned and the rising operating expenses. Over the past two years, the amount of offers from corporate companies to purchase the park have increased and the cost of core services has risen dramatically, specifically:

- Water system: The cost to upkeep and replace aging water lines is significant and involves much more than just the price of the new pipe. It's a major capital expense to ensure the continuous delivery of safe, clean drinking water.
- Sewer system: The costs to maintain clogs caused by wipes, grease and other materials not meant for the sewer system as well as maintaining the aging sewer pipes, manholes and storm drains.
- Trash removal, landscaping, snow removal, roads, insurance & property taxes: The cost in all these areas has increased significantly.

We remain committed to providing a clean, safe, and desirable place to call home. This adjustment ensures we can sustainably meet our rising costs, comply with municipal regulations, and continue to invest in the quality of the Arlington Woods community.

If you are a homeowner that resides at one of the corner lots or if your home is located close to one of our community roads, please reinforce your skirting with boards so that your skirting doesn't sustain damage from the snowplows during the winter months. Please do this in a neat & orderly fashion. Arlington Woods is not liable for snowplow damage done to your home while they are out plowing roads.

The Bureau of Construction Codes' dedicated mobile home community inspection team has been in place for a year and has enjoyed working with the manufactured housing community. Inspections, of all types, have been and will continue to be conducted by one of our four regulation officers assigned solely to mobile home community inspections. Our goal is for this highly talented and effective team to be a direct point of contact for you and work collaboratively to help manufactured housing communities maintain compliance with state of Michigan standards.

As a courtesy we wanted to provide a list of common concerns the regulation officers have been finding during their onsite inspections. We hope this will help to prepare all communities for upcoming inspections.

- Uncapped sewer pipes on vacant lots
- Open holes/water crocks (secured with hard cover) on vacant lots
- Uncapped water lines/risers on vacant lots
- Exposed electrical wires including telephone wires
- Unsecured electrical and breaker (emergency shut off) boxes on vacant lots, with or without a meter in the box.
- Unlocked gas valves on vacant lots
- Debris/rubbish/garbage throughout the park including occupied lots
- Indoor furniture and/or appliances outside of homes
- Excessive grass/weeds/trees growth/maintenance
- Missing skirting around homes
- Lots (vacant and occupied) not being clearly labeled with address and/or lot number
- Poor road conditions Potholes/drainage/overall condition
- Lack of appropriate water drainage
- Signs of rodent and/or insect infestations

Please also remember the following:

- All homes in mobile home communities must have HUD tags and/or Certificate of Manufactured Home Ownership and a Certificate of Mobile Home Title
- · Streetlights must be in working condition and properly maintained

Please note, this list is not all inclusive as to what the team is looking at and other items may be noted during inspections, including general health and safety concerns but we are focused on educating before regulating in LARA and the Mobile Home Community Inspection Section.


