2026 Lot Rent Increase:

Subject: Adjustment to Monthly Lot Rent and Commitment to Community Investment - Effective January 1, 2026

Dear Resident,

Effective January 1, 2026 the basic monthly lot rent for all lots will increase from \$460.00 to \$475.00, for an increase of \$15.00. We expect another increase in July 2026 of an additional \$15.00.

We understand a significant adjustment like this impacts your household budget, and we want to be fully transparent about the necessity and the direct benefit of this change. This decision was made after an extensive review of escalating operational costs and the needs of our community infrastructure and to stay competitive with the other communities in our area.

The primary drivers for this necessary adjustment are to keep the community locally owned and the rising operating expenses. Over the past two years, the amount of offers from corporate companies to purchase the park have increased and the cost of core services has risen dramatically, specifically:

- Water system: The cost to upkeep and replace aging water lines is significant and involves much more than just the price of the new pipe. It's a major capital expense to ensure the continuous delivery of safe, clean drinking water.
- Sewer system: The costs to maintain clogs caused by wipes, grease and other materials not meant for the sewer system as well as maintaining the aging sewer pipes, manholes and storm drains.
- Trash removal, landscaping, snow removal, roads, insurance & property taxes: The cost in all these areas has increased significantly.

We remain committed to providing a clean, safe, and desirable place to call home. This adjustment ensures we can sustainably meet our rising costs, comply with municipal regulations, and continue to invest in the quality of the Arlington Woods community.

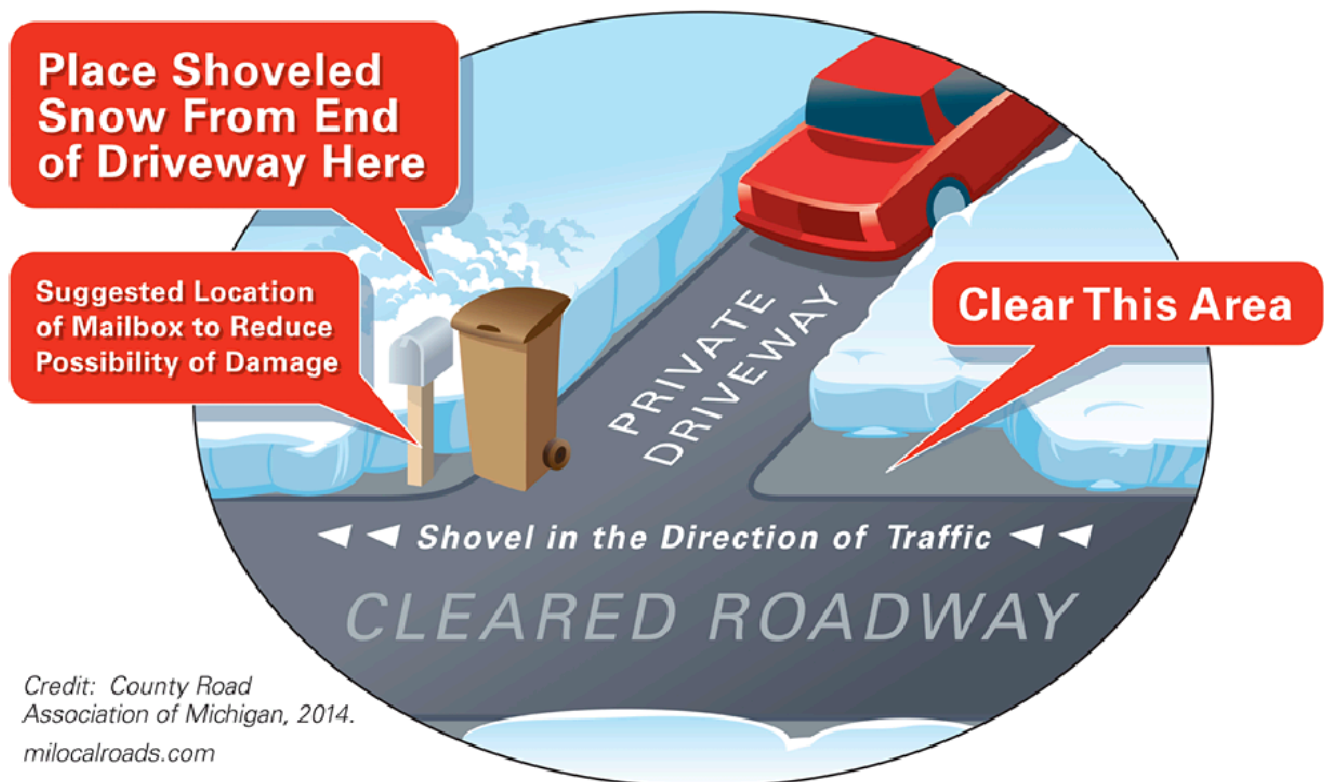


Winter Parking:

Please remember to park your vehicles on your off- street parking pad during winter months. Street parking from midnight to 7:00 am is prohibited. Any vehicles parked in the street are in violation of this rule and will be towed at the owners' expense without warning. Street parking during heavy winter storms at any time is also prohibited. Management normally plows during the early morning hours (2am-7am). Vehicles parked in the street make it impossible to plow properly. We appreciate all of you for your cooperation with this.

Avoid the “Second Shovel”

After a snowstorm, how many times have you shoveled your driveway only to have it plowed in when your local snowplow comes through? Clearing an area to the right of your driveway (as seen in the diagram below), giving the snow on the plow a place to go other than your driveway, should keep you from having to do the same job twice.

Homes Close To Roads/On Corner Lots:

If you are a homeowner that resides at one of the corner lots or if your home is located close to one of our community roads, please reinforce your skirting with boards so that your skirting doesn't sustain damage from the snowplows during the winter months. Please do this in a neat & orderly fashion. Arlington Woods is not liable for snowplow damage done to your home while they are out plowing the roads.

Snowplows and Damage:



Due to their size and power, there are many different ways a snowplow could damage your property.

- **Edges of Property:** The edges of your property are the most vulnerable to snowplow damages. Plows can dig into the ground, causing sections of the lawn to be lifted up or be removed entirely.
- **Sprinklers:** In ground sprinklers are usually placed along the edges of the lawn leaving them open to being hit by snowplows, rendering them useless.
- **Corner Posts and Yard Decor:** Corner posts and Yard Decor that is placed too close to the road are at risk of getting hit by a snowplow.

There are several ways to prevent different kinds of damages to your property from snowplows:

- **Mark Edges of Lawn:** Make it easier for snowplow drivers to see the edge of your lawn by putting brightly colored wooden stakes along the edges. Drivers are less likely to plow over your lawn if the edges are clearly marked.
- **Mark Irrigation Sprinkler Heads:** While you are marking the edges of your territory, add in some wooden stakes near your sprinkler heads as well for extra protection against snowplow damage.
- **Relocate or Remove Corner Posts and Yard Decor:** Remove yard decor and or corner posts to an appropriate area when it snows so snowplow drivers can clear up as much of the road as possible without damaging your items.

****Please remember that Arlington Woods is not liable for any damage you may incur from the snowplows.**



Easy Crockpot White Chicken Chili:

- 1 (48 ounce) jar great Northern beans
- 1 (16 ounce) jar salsa
- 8 ounces pepper Jack cheese, cut into chunks
- 1 (8 ounce) can white meat chicken, shredded

All trash cans put out on pick up day will need to be placed several feet from the road during the winter months. We do not want the plow trucks to damage them. Please keep in mind that the Garbage truck arms are only able to reach 9 feet so please do not place your trash can too far from the road.



Winter Reminders:

- Keep your roof/roof vents clear of snow and ice so your furnace will run smoothly.
- Let water stream the size of a pencil on cold days/nights to avoid freezing.
- Keep all skirting in place to protect pipes.
- Please do not park in the streets during winter storms as plows cannot properly clear the streets.
- Be sure to check and change your furnace filters as needed.

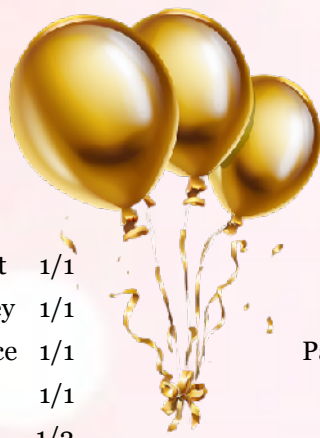
