PFAS RESULTS:

Arlington Woods 2019 PFAS Results

Arlington Woods was included in a state-funded quarterly sampling effort because our PFAS results in 2018 were greater than or equal to 10 parts per trillion (ppt) total PFAS or between 10 ppt and 70 ppt perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS) and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA). The results of 2019 PFAS samples collected from Arlington Woods on December 16, 2019 are below. A copy of the laboratory report in its entirety is in the office for your review.

Currently, there is no regulatory drinking water standard for any of the PFAS chemicals. However, in May 2016, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) established a non-regulatory Lifetime Health Advisory (LHA) for two of these chemicals, PFOS and PFOA. The LHA for PFOS and PFOA is 70 ppt combined, or individually if only one of them is present.

Our results are on the chart above, however a summary is listed below:

- PFBS = *ND
- PFHxA = *ND
- PFHxS = *ND
- PFOA = 2 parts per trillion (ppt)
- PFOS = 3 ppt
- PFOA+PFOS = 5 ppt
- Total PFAS = 5 ppt

The first sample collected on 3/27/2019 reported Total PFAS as 9 ppt and where PFOA+PFOS was 7 ppt.

JLT REPORT

The following 2 pages are from a rent study by JLT & Associates of Henderson, Nevada. This company does rent studies over the entire United States. This study is for manufactured home communities in Allegan, Ottawa & Muskegon counties. The entire study is 88 pages & is available in the office for your review.

The 2 pages show adjusted rents and a comparison for the 10 communities in Muskegon County. Actual rents are adjusted according to the services included in rent. Services that may be included are water (W), sewer (S), trash removal (T), & cable (C).

For Muskegon County water is valued at \$13 per month, sewer at \$32 per month, trash removal at \$18 per month & cable at \$40 per month. For Arlington actual rent is reduced by \$103 per month as water, sewer, trash removal & cable are all included. As the report states only 1 community, Arlington Woods, provides all 4 services.

The report also shows that of the 10 communities in Muskegon County, only 2 have lower adjusted rents than Arlington. As stated the entire report is available at the office for your review.
