### **PISPOSAL OF LEAVES:**

Just a reminder, we do not pick up leaves at the curbside. Each resident will be responsible for taking his or her leaves to the leaf dump site behind the East Community mailboxes which are located next to our office. Leaves should be picked up on a weekly basis to avoid damage to the grass and to keep the community looking nice.

If bags are used, they should not be stacked at the road nor kept at your home for a lengthy period of time (dispose of weekly). All leaves must be dumped from the bags. Either reuse the bags or dispose of them. Our dumpsite will not accept bags and this causes extra work for our team.

## **GOLF CARTS:**

Over the past several years, golf carts have been permitted to be driven in the community. In recent months it seems the amount of golf carts in the community has increased. Therefore we thought this would be a good time to remind everyone of the rules regarding golf carts:

- 1. Golf Carts may be operated on the community streets.
- 2. They must be driven by licensed adults.
- 3. Golf Carts cannot be driven to become an annoyance to other residents and cannot disturb the quiet enjoyment of his or her own home.
- 4. Golf Carts operated upon the streets shall abide by all laws and rules of the road applicable to motor vehicle traveling on the community streets.
- 5. The number of passengers shall be limited to the designed seating capacity of the golf cart.
- 6. No loud or bypassed mufflers are permitted.

We appreciate your cooperation by abiding by all the required regulations to continue golf carts being used in the community.

### NORTH COMMUNITY STORAGE AREA:

If you have any items stored in the North community overflow area near the playground, please remember to make other arrangements to store your items before November 1st. We use this area for our overflow snow during the winter months.
