RESIDENT INFO:

ANNUAL YARD SALE:

FENCES are not permitted to enclose any area on your site. We allow decorative fencing only and it must have written approval prior to being erected. If we need to enter the property to access a water or sewer line, we cannot have any obstruction.

WEEKLY & VEHICLE INSPECTIONS: Residents will be notified of Weekly and Vehicle inspections through email. Please check your email weekly for inspection notices. Please be sure your current email address is on file with us.

SPRING INSPECTIONS will be done toward the end of April and beginning of May. Theresa will be doing inspections this year, all inspections notices will be emailed to residents with pictures. We hope this will be easier for residents to know exactly what needs repair. Please be sure your email address is updated in the office. If you do not have an email address, we will mail your inspection report. Please be sure your home is washed or painted, leaves are raked, toys and all other items are put away, cement is edged, oil stains are removed, vehicles are licensed and in proper running order, steps and railings are in good shape and your home and lot are in nice, neat condition.

PETS are permitted with prior approval and ONE pet per household is allowed. All pets must be on a leash while outdoors and under the supervision of a responsible person. Feces must be cleaned up after each dropping & you cannot trespass onto other resident's property for use as a bathroom for your pet. Pets cannot be left to bark & disturb your neighbors.

Arlington Woods will not be promoting or advertising for an annual community yard sale this year due to COVID-19.

If you are interested in having a sale, it will be up to each individual resident to advertise or promote your own sale and may only be held on Saturday June 19 from 8am – 4pm if health guidelines & weather permits it. Tables, etc. may be put up at each resident's home site only. All items are to be cleared away by the end of the day. A rain date may only be set for Saturday, July 10th & all COVID-19 safety precautions are expected.

ODD/EVEN WATERING:

Properties with addresses that are even (the last number in your address), water on calendar days that are even. Properties with addresses that are odd, water on calendar days that are odd. There will be some even folks that are concerned about getting cheated because if there are 31 days in the month, there are two odd days in a row. Any 31st day of the month will be a "wild card" day and both odd and even addresses can water. However, they are being asked to apply only 50% of the irrigation water that they would normally apply on their normal watering day.

Residents with underground sprinkling are ok to water as they normally would in accordance with the times on the irrigation signed contract that is on file with the office and EGLE. (Any resident with underground sprinkling MUST have a signed contract on file).
