LOTRENTINCREASE:

Please see pages 2 and 3 for information regarding the 2022 lot rent increase.

This will be the only notice you will receive regarding the lot rent increase.

SPEEDING:

We have received several complaints of residents & their guests speeding in the community after 5pm when the office closes. All residents are held fully responsible for the actions of their guests while visiting and 3 or more written warnings may be cause for eviction. By State Law, the speed limit in manufactured housing communities is 15 mph at all times. No exceptions.

HOMES ON CORNER LOTS/ CLOSE TO ROADS:

If you are a homeowner that resides at one of the corner lots or if your home is located close to one of our community roads, please reinforce your skirting with boards so that your skirting doesn't sustain damage from the snowplows during the winter months. Please do this in a neat & orderly fashion. Arlington Woods is not liable for snowplow damage done to your home while they are out plowing the roads.

TRASH CANS & SNOW

All trash cans put out on pick up day will need to be placed several feet from the road during the winter months. We do not want the plow trucks to damage them. Please keep in mind that the Garbage truck arms are only able to reach 9 feet so please do not place your trash can too far from the road.

HOLIDAYTRASH PICK UP:

During the weeks of December 25, 2021 and January 1st, 2022, trash pick up for the Christmas and New Year's Day holidays will run on schedule. There will be no delay in trash pick up for either holiday. Please place your trash can out on Wednesday evening for a Thursday pick up as normal.

To all residents of Arlington Woods,

The time has come to announce the lot rent increase for 2022.

According to the Rent Comparison Report on the next page, Arlington Woods charges the third lowest adjusted rent which also includes the following services: Water, Sewer, Cable and Trash (W/S/T/C listed on the report). These four services, on average, would cost you another \$103 per month if they were not included. As you can see, most of the other communities do not include as many services yet they charge more for their base (market) rent.

Because of our low adjusted rent combined with the services we include, several large companies have attempted to purchase Arlington Woods over the last few years. Historically, these large companies increase rent while reducing the services included.

In an effort to remain an independent, locally owned company, we will be increasing our rent over the next few years to bring us in line with the other communities in our area.

For next year, our increase will be \$15 per month beginning on January 1, 2022. This substantial increase is necessary to keep our community locally owned and operated as well as cover the increase in costs to maintain the community.

We believe we provide the best value of any manufactured community in Muskegon County and will continue to do so providing our rents are closely comparable to surrounding communities.

- HAVE YOUR FURNACE INSPECTED, CLEANED & CHANGE THE FILTERS.
- CHECK THE HEATTAPE UNDER YOUR HOME TO BE SURE IT IS IN PROPER WORKING ORDER.
- HAVE ALL SKIRTING IN PLACE TO PROTECT PIPES.
- LET YOUR WATER RUNTHE SIZE OF A PENCIL ON COLD DAYS/NIGHTS TO AVOID PIPES FROM FREEZING.
- INSULATE & BOX IN THE EXTERIOR WATER PIPES LEADING TO YOUR HOME.

Avoid the "Second Shovel"

People can play a part in ensuring the ends of their driveways remain clear of snow even after their local snowplow comes through. Shoveling a "corner" of the right-of-way free of snow in the area several feet before the driveway will help keep that same snow from being pushed into the driveway in an icy, heavy pile. Clearing an area large enough to hold the snow coming off the plow may help reduce the "second shovel."
