Lot Rent Increase:

To all residents of Arlington Woods,

For the upcoming year, our increase will be \$15 per month beginning on January 1, 2023.

This substantial increase is necessary to keep our community locally owned and operated as well as cover the increased costs to maintain the community. Not to mention that the rising inflation is driving up our costs on nearly everything. We believe we provide the best value of any manufactured community in Muskegon County and will continue to do so providing our rents are closely comparable to surrounding communities.

Prevent Snowplow Damage:

What Kind of Damage Can Snowplows Cause?

Due to their massive size and power, there are many different ways a snowplow could damage your property.

- Edges of Property: The edges of your property are the most vulnerable to snowplow damages. Plows can dig into the ground, causing sections of the lawn to be lifted up or be removed entirely.
- Sprinklers: In ground sprinklers are usually placed along the edges of the lawn leaving them open to being hit by snowplows, rendering them useless.
- Mailboxes: Snowplows can end up hitting mailboxes at the end of the driveway because they can't see them, causing them to knock down or destroy completely.
- Corner Posts and Yard Decor: Corner posts and Yard Decor that is placed too close to the road are at risk of getting hit by a snowplow.

Preventing Snowplow Damage to Your Property

There are several ways to prevent different kinds of damages to your property from snowplows.

- Mark Edges of Lawn: Make it easier for snowplow drivers to see the edge of your lawn by putting brightly colored wooden stakes along the edges. Drivers are less likely to plow over your lawn if the edges are clearly marked.
- Mark Irrigation Sprinkler Heads: While you are marking the edges of your territory, add in some wooden stakes near your sprinkler heads as well for extra protection against snowplow damage.
- Relocate the Mailbox: Make sure your mailbox is not too close to the road.
- Relocate or Remove Corner Posts and Yard Decor: Remove yard decor and or corner posts to an appropriate area when it snows so snowplow drivers can clear up as much of the road as possible without damaging your items.

Auto Withdrawal:

We can set up automatic withdrawals from your checking/ savings account to pay your monthly lot rent without any worries. We are able to extend that same offer for your home payments as well. In short, you will be able to have all of your monthly payments deducted straight from your checking or savings and paid straight to us with no late fees or worries!

Be sure to grab a sign up form if you're interested.

You can also set up automatic withdrawal through our Tenant Web Access.

Winter Parking:

Please remember to park your vehicles on your off- street parking pad during winter months. Street parking from midnight to 7:00 am is prohibited. Any vehicles parked in the street are in violation of this rule and will be towed at the owners' expense without warning. Street parking during heavy winter storms is also prohibited. Management normally plows during the early morning hours (3am-7am). Vehicles parked in the street make it impossible to plow properly. We appreciate all of your cooperation with this.

Winter Reminders:

- Keep roof vents clear of ice & snow.
- Check the heat tape under your home to be sure it is in proper working order.
- Have all skirting in place to protect pipes.
- Let your water stream on cold days/nights to avoid pipes from freezing.

Patio Sheds:

Each home without a garage is required to have a patio shed within 60 days after occupancy of the home. All sheds are to be located behind the home unless Management approves a different location. Wooden sheds are encouraged-keep them well painted & in good condition. If your shed is not properly maintained, Management may require you to remove it from the community. Only one shed per lot is allowed. Additional sheds require Management approval prior to constructing. They may not interfere with your neighbor's enjoyment of his/her site. Temporary sheds are not permitted. You are also responsible for any permits required by Muskegon Charter Township.

Trash Carts:

All trash cans put out on pick up day will need to be placed several feet from the road during the winter months. We do not want the plow trucks to damage them. Please keep in mind that the Garbage truck arms are only able to reach 9 feet so please do not place your trash can too far from the road.

Dropbox:

There is a dropbox located at the front of the office for your convenience.

Please be sure to have the address of the home you want your payment applied to on the check/ money order when placing them into the dropbox for payments.

Storage Area:

When entering and exiting the South Storage area, PLEASE remember to shut and lock the gate. We installed the gate to keep the area locked and secured. There have been several times we get called because it was left open. Also, when opening and shutting the gate DO NOT slam it. When you do this it relocates the rollers and makes the gate impossible to open. It rolls very smooth and can be opened and closed properly.

We appreciate your cooperation.

Homes On Corner Lots or Close To Roads:

If you are a homeowner that resides at one of the corner lots or if your home is located close to one of our community roads, please reinforce your skirting with boards so that your skirting doesn't sustain damage from the snowplows during the winter months. Please do this in a neat & orderly fashion. Arlington Woods is not liable for snowplow damage done to your home while they are out plowing the roads.

Remove yard decor and or corner posts to an appropriate area when it snows so snowplow drivers can clear up as much of the road as possible without damaging your items.
